## School Admission Appeals Timetable 1 March 2023 – 29 February 2024

School Admission appeals are administered in accordance with the requirements of the 2012 School Admission Appeals Code issued by the Department for Education. Parents whose admission application is refused will have the legal right to appeal that decision. To lodge an appeal, complete and return the Appeal Form which can be downloaded from the School website or requested from the School Office.

On receipt of the completed Appeal Form, the Admission Authority will arrange for an appeal hearing to take place before an independent Appeal Panel. The timetable differs depending on when the appeal is lodged and whether it relates to an application to transfer to Year 9 at the school in September 2023 or to join the School during the academic year 2023/2024.

## Transferring to Year 9 in September 2023 – For appeals lodged after 30th March 2023

Appeals lodged after 30th March 2023 will be heard within 40 school days of the appeal deadline or 30 school days of being lodged, whichever is the later date.

## Lodging an appeal following receipt of an In-Year admission application decision

An appeal may be lodged within **30 school days** of the admission decision being issued. An appeal hearing will be scheduled to take place within **30 school days** of receipt of the appeal form
