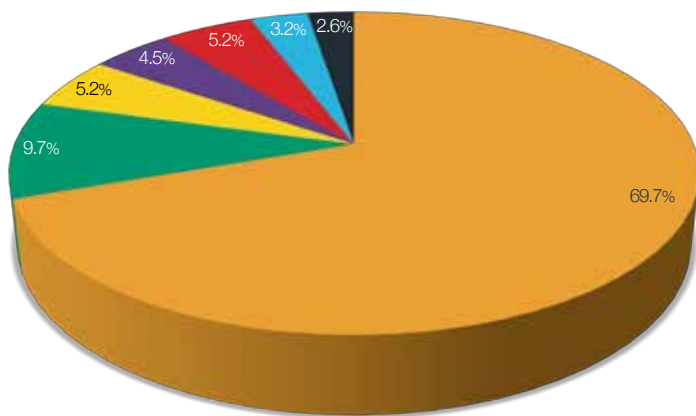

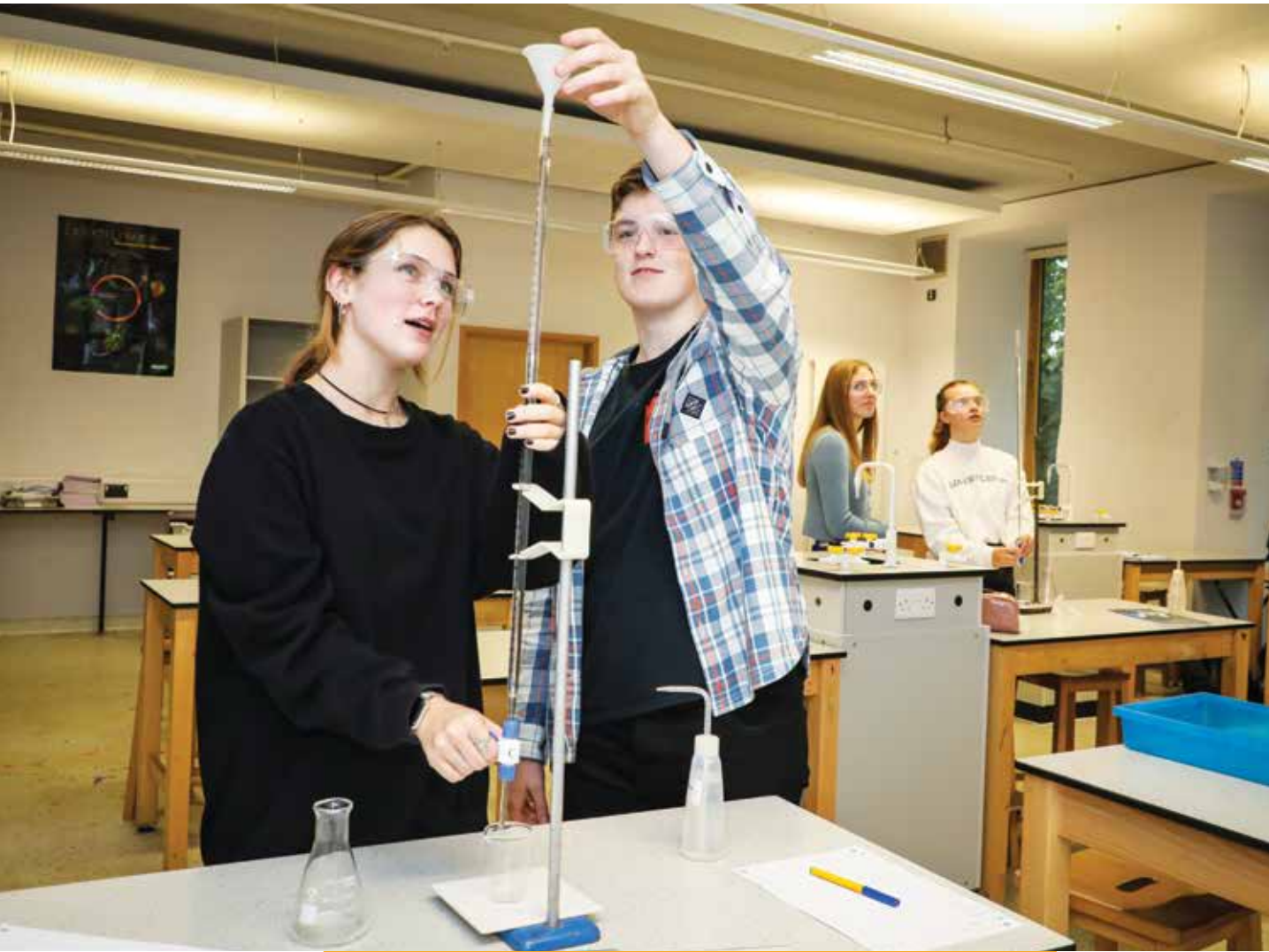

Programmes of Study



Programmes of Study at Queen Elizabeth’s School consist of a tutor programme, 3 academic courses (4 in some cases) plus an enrichment course. All are designed to prepare you for further education, an apprenticeship, employment or training. The academic courses could consist of A Levels, BTECs or a mix of both. The courses selected will make up your Pathway, of which there are 3: A Level, Mixed Pathway and Professional.

The courses available as part of the Programme of Study are subject to achieving the entry requirements. These are outlined in the table below. All courses are linear and last for 2 years.

Work Experience can be part of the Study Programme but this needs to be organised once you have been accepted into Queen Elizabeth’s School.

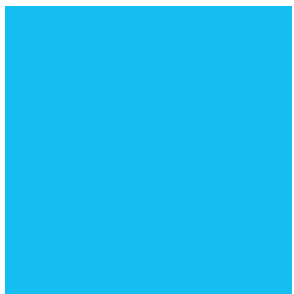
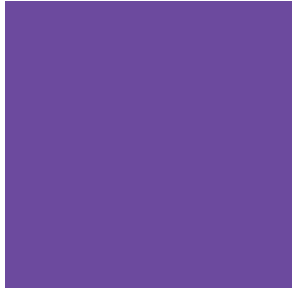
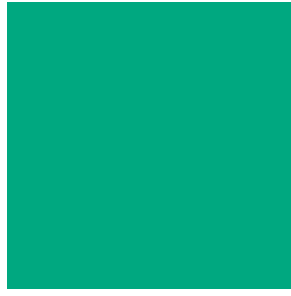
