

Spend time talking to staff about our curriculum tonight: we love what we teach!




Community and Care

What is the impact of our work?



A-Level and GCSE Results

- KS4: Our 4+ English and Maths results are above the Dorset average and at national average.
- Our disadvantaged student pass rates increased by 5% in English and maths.
- Results in Art, Dance, Sociology, Sport, Spanish and French are in the top 35% of the country.
- At A Level our 'Value Added' is now at national average after being below last year.
- We send students to the very best universities, including Oxbridge. Students have also gone on to study medicine, architecture and veterinary science from the 'Class of 2025'.

Parent Survey Results

- My child is happy at this school: up 10%
- The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year: up 12%
- The school has high expectations for my child: up 16%
