Remember, if something makes you or someone you know uncomfortable, this is not acceptable!



Hazing/Initiation.

This could include harassment, abuse or humiliation used to initiate a person into a group



Bullying

Includes cyberbullying, prejudice based and discriminatory bullying



Upskirting

Typically involves taking a picture under a person's clothing without their permission



Inappropriate Touching

Someone could have smacked your bottom while you were walking past...



Physical Abuse

This could include hitting, kicking, shaking, biting, hair pulling or online abuse which facilitates physical abuse



Sexualised comments and sexualised images

Anything that could be sexual, including comments about your body

Engagement

Why	Explained
A) To Learn from Mistakes:	Remembering past failures, like a time you got a bad grade because you didn't study, helps you learn to change your behaviour for next time. It stops you from repeating the same errors.
B) To Honour People and Events:	Remembering historical events like the sacrifices made in wars or the achievements of a civil rights leader helps us appreciate the struggles and contributions of others.
C) To Build Identity:	Remembering your family history, where your relatives came from, or personal experiences like a favourite childhood memory helps shape who you are. It gives you a sense of belonging and a personal story.
D) To Stay Grateful:	Remembering acts of kindness you've received, like a friend helping you with a difficult project, keeps you grounded and grateful for the people in your life. It encourages you to pay that kindness forward.
E) To Preserve Culture and Tradition:	Remembering cultural celebrations, stories, and traditions (like cooking a family recipe passed down through generations) connects you to your heritage. It ensures that valuable traditions aren't lost over time.

Amen.


