Week	Art Independent Study Tasks
<b>1</b> <b>Photography</b>	<b>A03</b> <input type="checkbox"/> Take a series of photographs inspired by your mind map, ideas and chosen artist and artist links. Try and look at a range of different source inspirations. Try zooming in on details and textures as well as exploring composition and colour. <b>Extension task / Stretch &amp; Challenge:</b> - Explore digital manipulation / processes such as Photoshop or Procreate to develop your ideas further.
<b>2 &amp; 3</b> <b>Experimentation with materials in the style of your chosen artist &amp; final planning</b>	<b>A03</b> <input type="checkbox"/> Using your own photographs / recent drawings and studies, explore and experiment with media, materials and techniques in the style of your chosen artist, improving and refining the handling of materials, developing your work towards your final outcome. <input type="checkbox"/> Final planning for your final outcome. Include thumbnail compositional designs. Which one will you choose and why?  You may complete a number of experimental studies in the style of your chosen artist exploring a range of different materials or using mixed media.  You may wish to explore digital manipulation, exploring colour, texture and composition in the style of your chosen artist - either on Photoshop, PhotoPea or Procreate. Alternatively, you could use physical collage to explore ideas.
<b>4 &amp; 5</b> <b>Final outcome and sketchbook work</b>	<b>A04</b> <input type="checkbox"/> Complete your Growth and Decay final piece <input type="checkbox"/> Complete all sketchbook work to date. Ensure there are no GAPS!
<b>6</b> <b>Evaluation</b>	<b>A01, A02, A03, A04</b> <b>Ensure all aspects of your project are completed by the deadline including your final outcome, your sketchbook and your evaluation.</b>
