Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: QE Restructure Update

Thank you for the questions and feedback that you've shared with the school in the last ten days regarding the ongoing restructure at Queen Elizabeth's School.

I understand that parents and carers may be concerned about the impact of the proposed redundancies on our curriculum. I have recently published the list of A Level subjects that we will be running next year in a letter to year 11 parents: [A Level Options Letter](#).

The GCSE options evening is on 19 March 2026 and on that evening, the final list of options subjects available to students for their GCSEs will be published. In the meantime, I am able to provide you with last year's booklet and confirm that only a small number of subjects will be removed from the curriculum. Last year's options subjects are linked here: [GCSE Options 2024-25](#).

The year 9 curriculum will be unaffected by the changes and students will continue to study the full range of national curriculum subjects at QE.

I would like to respond to queries and concerns raised and to that end the school has created a Google Form for you to record feedback in the following areas:

1. What are your main concerns or questions about the proposed restructure of Queen Elizabeth School?
2. Which aspects of the restructure would you like more clarity on?
3. What information would be most helpful to you as we move through the restructure process?
