Year 11 Easter Revision Programme

We believe that this programme will make a significant difference to your child's preparation and help boost their confidence ahead of the exams. We strongly recommend all Year 11 students consider attending, but we understand that family commitments may impact participation.

In addition to the Easter revision, during the exam period students will have a bespoke timetable where revision sessions will happen during the school day. As such students will be expected to be in school during normal school hours to maximise the benefit of these. There will also be a May half term schedule but this will follow at a later date.

As we approach the GCSE examination period, we would also like to provide you with important information regarding the timetable and contingency arrangements.

The contingency day for exams is **Thursday 24 June**. In the event of any disruption, this day may be used to accommodate exams that cannot take place as scheduled so please do not arrange any holidays until after this date.

Once the exams commence, a **bespoke timetable** will be in place for students. On days when a student **does not have an exam or a scheduled revision session**, they will be permitted to **sign out from 1:30 pm**. Please note that at all other times, students **will not be able to leave school** as normal processing will not be possible.
