Who Can Have the MenACWY/TdiPV Vaccine

All students in YEAR 9 and above are eligible to get their Men ACWY TdiPV vaccine at school

Students are given two injections one after the other in the upper arm (each arm or same arm intramuscular)

How do I get the Men ACWY/TDipV vaccine



Your parent/carer needs to ensure they fill out the online consent form for you to get the vaccine



If we do not have consent via the online consent form you will not be vaccinated



An offer letter will be sent from your school, to your parents/carers. They must complete the online consent form before the deadline for you to receive the vaccines when the nurses attend your school throughout March, April and May 2026

Catch Up Clinics

If you missed your vaccine at school there will be an opportunity to book a local catch up clinic where you can attend with a parent/carer

Your parent/carer will receive an email as an invite to book a time slot at the catch up clinic at your convenience
