Dear Parent/Carer,

Further to our letter in the Autumn term outlining the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) that was delivered to your child, we are now writing to provide additional information regarding an upcoming session for Year 10 pupils of Triple Science, which will take place after the half term break.

On Tuesday 30 June, students will participate in a session delivered by Sexual Health Dorset, focusing on sexually transmitted infections (STIs). This session forms part of our commitment to providing high-quality RSHE in line with Department for Education guidance. NHS Sexual Health Dorset are experienced professionals who regularly work with young people in educational settings.

The aims of the session are to support students in developing their understanding of key aspects of sexual health and personal responsibility. Specifically, students will:

- Know where to go and how to gain advice and help on sexual health and relationship issues
- Understand that sexual activity may result in sexually transmitted infections: the consequences and implications
- Understand what is meant by “safer sex” and how to minimise the risks attached to sexual activity
- Understand that individuals have responsibility for their own and their partner’s safety

The content will be delivered in a sensitive, age-appropriate manner by trained professionals. Students will also have the opportunity to ask questions in a safe and respectful environment.
