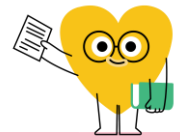




# MYTIME'S EMPLOYABILITY COURSE



MYTIME young carers are inviting young carers from Queen Elizabeth School to take part in an Employability course in September 2026. The programme exists to support young carers to explore career opportunities that might interest them, & to build plans for the future.

## What is it?

MYTIME's employability course takes place during the school day. Courses are led by Career and Employability Advisors Clary & Daphna.

The course will cover:

- ▷ A CV-writing workshop;
- ▷ Interview skills and mock interviews;
- ▷ Personality profiling (designed by The Colour Works Foundation);
- ▷ Presentations from motivational speakers, successful entrepreneurs, and former young carers;
- ▷ 1:1 careers guidance appointments.

After completing the course everyone can access continued support from MYTIME, until their 26<sup>th</sup> birthday. This includes help finding or applying to courses, work experience placements or jobs.

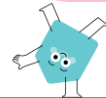
