Dear Parents and Carers,

I'm writing with an update on the weather warnings that have been issued today. We are aware of the Met Office 'Red' alert that has been issued for some parts of the UK but with some adaptations, we are confident that we can remain fully open and run a normal timetable for all year groups this week. This is in large part due to the size of our site and the fact that two year groups (year 11 and year 13) are not in school, giving us more flexibility with use of the site.

The adjustments we are making are as follows:

1. PE lessons will be moved indoors.
2. The PE kit option for uniform will remain in place until the end of this week.
3. Students are being encouraged to fill up water bottles and manage hydration during the day.
4. Classes can be re-roomed to cool areas of the school and we are doing this where required.

We will continue to follow the [DFE's guidance](#) on managing schools during hot weather and heatwaves.

I have walked the site this afternoon to review the temperatures around the site. We have over 34 classrooms which will remain cool in the heat, some because they are north facing, others due to air conditioning or good ventilation. This is enough to accommodate all of our classes and we have begun to re-room groups where necessary.
