Outside of my school work, I also teach skateboarding at local outdoor skatepark.

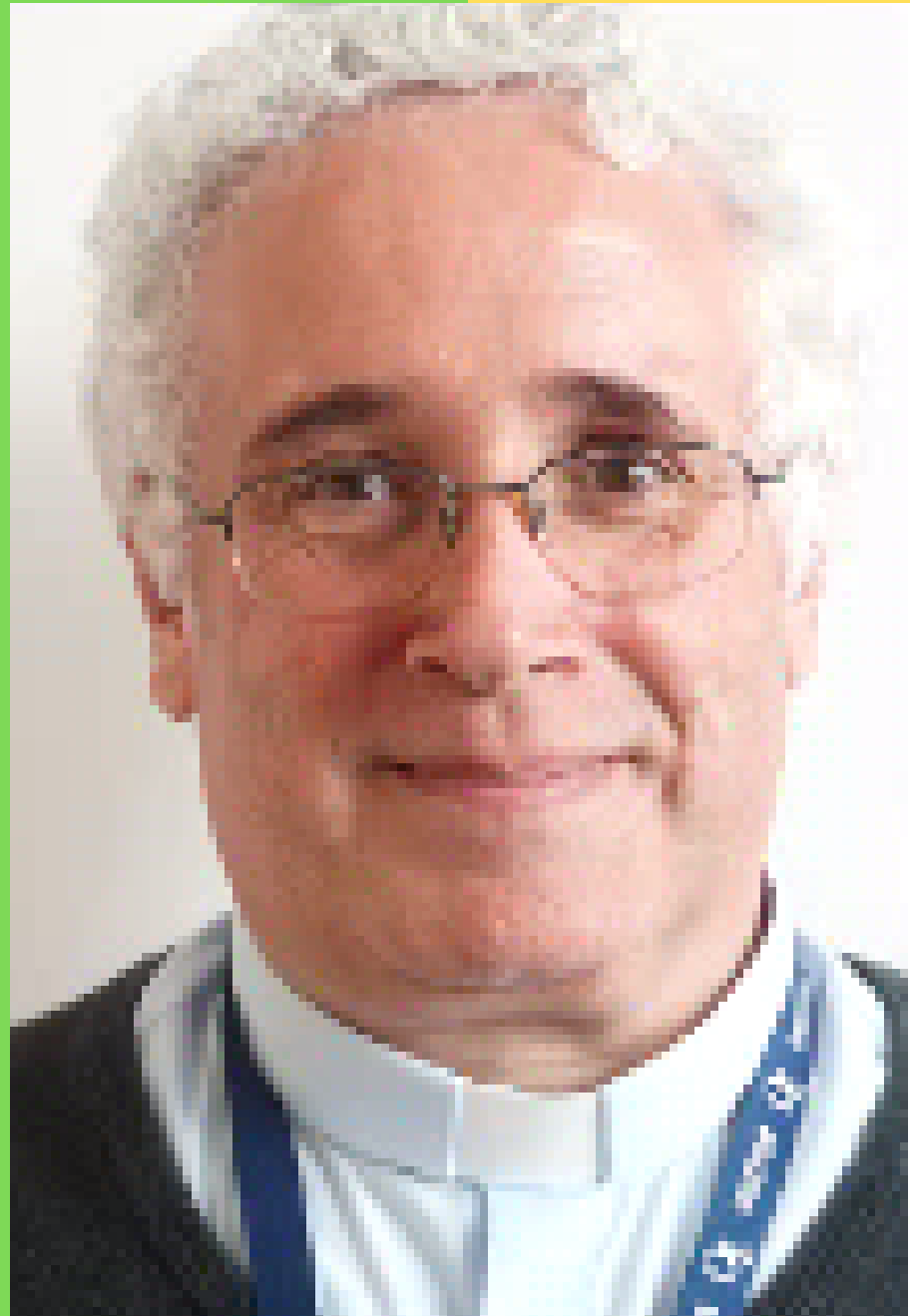
I have been a Christian for over 18 years now, after finding my faith while living out in America.
