Re: A-Level & GCSE Results Day Information: Including New Digital Results Access for Yr 11

- **Thursday 13 August 2026, 8am-11am A Level results**
- **Thursday 20 August 2026, 9am-11am GCSE results**

We would like to share again important information about results day arrangements and exciting changes to how results can be accessed. Please see [here](#) for important information ahead of results day for GCSE students.

On results day, students will be invited into school at the usual time to collect their final grades in person from their teachers and pastoral staff. This is an important opportunity to discuss next steps, celebrate achievements, and receive support in interpreting results or considering alternative pathways where appropriate. We encourage all students to come into school to collect their results.

From this summer 2026, students will also have digital access to GCSE results via a freely available app. This is a new national initiative announced by the Department for Education. Year 11 students across England will be able to view their GCSE results digitally on their smartphones via the Education Record app, marking a significant move toward modernising exam records. Please download the app before results day.

This new app aims to:

- Allow students to access their GCSE results on their phones securely and quickly.
- Provide lifelong access to verified qualifications, making it easier to share results with future employers or further education providers.
- Reduce the chance of lost or damaged paper certificates.
- Support smoother transitions into post-16 pathways by giving colleges and schools timely access to key student information such as English and maths achievement and additional support needs.



Please note that this digital access does not replace the face-to-face results process on results day. Students should still come into school to receive their results personally and can then use the app later in the day once the results are published. See more here:
