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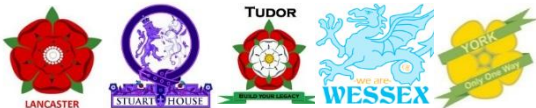
Timetables

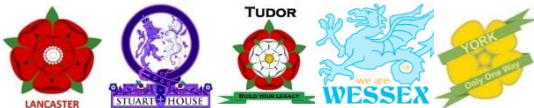

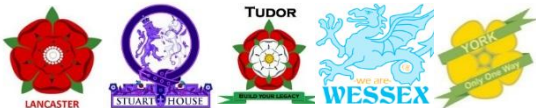

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Key UCAS statistics: 2022

- 139 students completed a UCAS application
- 67 students applied to one or more Russell Group university
- 4 students had interviews for Oxbridge, one got a place at Cambridge
- 2 students are going to study Medicine this year
- Our students are going to 36 different institutions studying courses ranging from accounting to sports coaching.

Attendance:

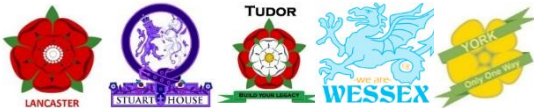
- Expected to remain on school site between the hours of 8:40 am - 3:05 pm
