Placements need to be secured by **20th March 2023** so over the coming weeks you need to start making contact with employers.

How to begin:

1. Create a CV
2. Create a covering Letter
3. Compile a list of potential Employers (you will need to approach many)
4. Call ahead and get details of who best to contact (Sound Confident/Enthusiastic)
5. Send Emails/ Letters but don't forget where possible meeting Face to Face is the best!
