QUESTION

How is the work exhibited?

What is the scale of the artwork?

What textures can you see?

Are you surprised by any aspect of the artwork?

Is the exhibition displaying artwork

by a number of artists or just one?

What colours are the walls?

What have you noticed?

DO

Complete 2-3 observational drawings of the artwork.

These can be quick, loose drawings, timed drawings, continuous line drawings.

Make notes about the artwork and what you see.

Analyse one artwork in detail.

Write down the name of the artist, the date it was created, the title.

CREATE

Once back at home, create a double page in your sketchbook on your gallery visit. Include the following information:

- * A title - the name of the gallery or exhibition that you visited
- * Your 2-3 observational drawings - these can be worked on at home, if necessary
- * Any photographs that you took at the exhibition
- * Collage - postcards / exhibition leaflets etc
- * Analysis of one artwork in detail
- * Any thoughts on the initial QUESTIONS about the gallery space
